A roll call vote was called for: Steve – aye, Charlotte – aye, Lorin – aye, John - aye. Approved unanimously.

Mayor Christensen gave the State of the City address for 2009. He discussed the items that have been completed in the city over the past year; the sign and gazebo at Kiwanis Park, a new shelter at the City Park, landscaping at Anderson Park, a new restroom at Brinkman Park, a groundbreaking ceremony for the wastewater treatment plant which will be completed by April 30, 2010, the annexation of the city into the Shelley/Firth Fire District, and one of our Police Officers completed POST training. Mayor Christensen said he is pleased to be the Mayor of our city, and plans to run for re-election in 2009. He said the previous administrations have left a good strong legacy for the citizens. Mayor Christensen said the city is in good financial condition and he pledges to keep the city that way. He said he appreciates the great staff the city has, which makes him look great. Mayor Christensen said people want to live in the Shelley Community. He said right now we are in a building slump, but feels the proposed business in the Idaho Falls area will have a positive effect on our city. Mayor Christensen said he wants to continue to maintain the quality of life we have in our city, and it is an excellent place to raise a family. Mayor Christensen said everyone has an image to maintain and he will make every effort to keep the city in good standing. He finished his address with his familiar quote of "Lets Move Onward and Upward".

Dawn said every year she has the opportunity to choose two people that show excellent basketball skills, combined with school skills, etc. for the All Regional Jazz Awards. She said this year she has chosen Abby Chapple and Chase Cather. Mayor Christensen and Dawn presented awards to the two youth.

Mayor Christensen made the following assignments to the Council for 2009; Charlotte – City Hall Administration, Tree Committee liaison, P&Z liaison, and School Board liaison. John – Park and Recreation, Urban Renewal Board liaison, and Comp Plan Committee liaison. Steve – Public Works, City Engineer, and Economic Development liaison. Lorin – Police, City Attorney, and SICOG liaison.

Mayor Christensen asked each council member to make the motion for the appropriate department head for 2009. Lorin moved, Steve seconded to appoint Alan Dial as Police Chief for 2009. Approved unanimously. Lorin moved, Charlotte seconded to appoint BJ Driscoll as City Attorney for 2009. Approved unanimously. Steve moved, John seconded to appoint Rick Anderson as Public Works Director for 2009. Approved unanimously. Steve moved, John seconded to appoint Forsgren Engineering as the City Engineer for 2009. Approved unanimously. John moved, Steve seconded to appoint Dawn Lloyd as Parks and Recreation Director for 2009. Approved unanimously. Charlotte moved, John seconded to appoint Sandy Gaydusek as City Clerk/Treasurer. Approved unanimously. Lorin moved, Charlotte seconded to appoint Doug Keele as City Building Inspector for 2009. Approved unanimously.

Sandy said the city received a dividend check from the State Insurance Fund in the amount of \$3696. Lorin moved, John seconded to award each employee one safety day to be used as Personal Leave and a \$50 bonus for being safe in the work place. The balance will be appropriated to the General Fund. Approved unanimously.

Sandy said Bingham County has requested comments for a mini one lot subdivision west of the City at approximately 1498 N. 475 E. The council had no concerns other than suggesting adequate lighting be used in the subdivision.

Sandy presented a bankruptcy claim she received for Connie Downs previously of 290 Brent Way. John moved, Lorin seconded to write off \$40.24 owed by Connie Downs. Approved unanimously.

Sandy said when the budget was approved, the city was in the process of Judicial Confirmation for an additional 2 million dollars to be added to the bond for the waste water treatment plant. She said most of the State Revenue Sharing Funds were allocated to the sewer treatment plant in the event that Judicial Confirmation was not awarded. A new police car that usually is purchased through State Revenue Sharing Funds was purchased with funds from the General Fund. Sandy asked that the Mayor and Council give permission to transfer \$25,000 back to the General Fund from the State Revenue Sharing Fund since Judicial Confirmation was awarded. Lorin moved, Charlotte seconded to transfer \$25,000 from the State Revenue Sharing Fund to the General Fund to replace the funds to purchase a police vehicle for 2008-2009 fiscal year. Approved unanimously.

Sandy presented a list of 106 applications for a General Business License for 2009. (list of license applications attached) She said there were more applications submitted for the newly

implemented General Business License than she thought there would be. John moved, Steve seconded to approve 106 Business License for 2009 as presented and attached. Approved unanimously. Sandy said she intends on placing each business and their information on the city web site. John suggested that Brandon Bird and the Kiwanis be given a list of city businesses. He also suggested that a list of business be given out to new residents in the city.

BJ said Sandy asked him to check into the bankruptcy filed by DBSI Inc that the city was sent notice for. He said it is unknown how this company is tied to the city, but several other businesses from the Shelley area are listed as creditors. BJ said that DBSI Inc. is a Real Estate Development Company and the debt may be related to construction. He said the city should receive more information regarding this bankruptcy later on.

BJ said he revised the agreement with Snake River Valley Irrigation District regarding the mitigation for the city's water rights, but we are still waiting for the Irrigation District's response. He said he will be presenting this agreement to the council at a future meeting. BJ said the agreement should be ironed out so a new hearing can be re-scheduled to discuss the city's application for water rights.

BJ requested an executive session to discuss pending litigation.

Sandy said there will be a Planning and Zoning Workshop in Pocatello on February 28, 2009, which is a Saturday. She asked if the members of the P&Z Board should be given the opportunity to attend this workshop. The Council gave permission for those on the P&Z Board to attend this workshop if they wish.

Sandy presented the 2008 statistics for parking citations in the city as drafted by Officer Robert Tincher.

Sandy said there will be a workshop for building inspectors in Post Falls at the end of this month. She said Doug needs credits to retain his building code certification. Sandy said the cost to attend this three-day workshop is \$1122.05. She said only \$700 has been budgeted for training. The council asked that Sandy speak with Doug and see if there is alternate training he may be able to attend a little closer than Post Falls to save expenses. Sandy said she would telephone poll everyone if there is no alternate training available.

Sandy said Kurt Wells and Robert Hill had a strip of their property annexed into the city limits by mistake when the North Shelley Business Park was annexed. She said Brent Christensen submitted the legal description for North Shelley Business Park and typically the city does not verify the legal description due to the cost. Sandy said the property owner is responsible to make sure the legal description is accurate. She said she contacted Mr. Christensen regarding this matter and he offered to pay any additional property taxes on Mr. Wells, and Mr. Hill's property, however Mr. Wells wants de-annexed. Sandy said Mr. Christensen will be responsible to submit the legal description for de-annexation of Mr. Wells and Mr. Hills property.

John asked what the status is on the gazebo that was vandalized on the walking path. Dawn said there is a Scout who was refurbishing the gazebo as an Eagle Scout project when the vandalism occurred. She said ICRMP has been contacted and they are holding the file until the project can be completed next spring. Dawn said the Youth Coalition would like to re-build the gazebo out of metal instead of wood. The Scout may be able to return some of the supplies he has purchased if the Youth Coalition intends on building a new metal gazebo.

Dawn said a grant was written for ten sets of golf clubs. She said the grant was awarded and she has turned the golf clubs over to Hobbs Middle School for their students to learn to play golf.

Rick said when the North Shelley Business Park was constructed Brent Christensen put in a twelve-inch water line instead of the required eight-inch line. Sandy said the minutes show that Mr. Christensen was suppose to upgrade from a six inch line to an eight inch line and the city would pay for the upgrade with a \$17000 cap. Rick said since there was the possibility of future development north of this project Mr. Christensen agreed that he would put in a twelve-inch line if the city would pay for the upgrade from an eight-inch line to a twelve-inch line. Rick was instructed by the Council to measure the footage of the line and the number of valves the city is being charged for. Rick said Mr. Christensen would like his inspection fees he owes the city deducted from what the city owes him. The Council instructed Rick to negotiate the cost of the water line with Mr. Christensen when the measurements have been taken.

Lorin said he is not in favor of the new grade school being built in the county, and not the city. He said the city will be furnishing the water for the school and he would like to look at annexing their property. However, Lorin said he felt we should wait to start this annexation until the challenge to the annexation of Kelley Acres was resolved.

Lorin said Journey's End Golf Course is being sold. He said he is concerned over what will happen to the golf course.

Lorin said Basic American Foods will be laying off sixty upper management positions. He said two of their lines have been terminated at the Shelley Plant. Lorin said this may effect property taxes that the city receives. He said we are facing hard economic times, but the city will be optimistic.

Mayor Christensen said there will be 1000 feet of 40-inch experimental sewer line installed on County Club road near Merlin Dial's home running west. He said the line is certified for storm water, but has not been certified for sanitary sewer water. Mayor Christensen said the contractors are confident this line will work for sanitary sewer, but needs to check it out before it is installed for the large transmission line from Ammon to Shelley. He said if this line is deemed acceptable it will save 5 million dollars in project costs.

Mayor Christensen said he will be attending a Legislative Luncheon in Boise on January 29, 2009. He said there will be a Regional Authority meeting on the same day. John said he will attend the meeting in the Mayor's place.

Lorin moved, John seconded to adjourn into executive session pursuant to Idaho Code 67-2345(f) to discuss pending litigation. Approved unanimously.

Lorin moved, Steve seconded to reconvene into regular session. Approved unanimously.

Mayor Christensen said during executive session pending litigation was discussed.
