Mayor Pascoe called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Kim moved, Adam seconded to approve the following consent agenda:

- Minutes of May 28, 2015
- Approval of May 2015 Overall Budget & Treasurer's Rpt.
- Approval of May 2015 Expenditures
- Building Permits: None

A roll call vote was taken: Earl- aye, Kim – aye, Jeff – aye, and Adam-aye.
Approved unanimously.

Stan Searle representing the STARRC Organization addressed the Mayor and Council regarding a fund raiser they are considering. Mr. Searle said they would like to help fund the Recreation District election by having a Color Fun Run. He said the run may take place at Bingham County Park and extend into the County area and then back to Bingham County Park. He said they may change the starting location to the start of the path which is in the city limits. Mr. Searle said this will be held sometime the first part of August. Kim asked about the mess the colored chalk may make. Adam said it is colored cornstarch, and they are planning to have a Color Run for Spud Day too. The Mayor and Council said they are okay with the Color Run. Adam said he is concerned about people turning out for both the proposed Spud Day Color Run and the STARRC Color Run. Debi Wilson arrived and said the run will be August 8, 2015, and they have been working with the Bingham County Sheriff's Office on this matter. She said the Color Run will be hosted at the North Bingham County Park, and they hope to raise about \$14,000 which is needed for the election. Mrs. Wilson said the Bingham County Sheriff has agreed to help with traffic control, and the organization has some sponsors that will help also. She said the run will begin at the Bingham County Park and they will continue down the River Road. She said the runners will probably not be entering the city.

Kong Khamone was not in attendance.

Adam moved, Earl seconded to approve the Fireworks Permit applications for:
Kings – 600 N. State (inside store)
Kings – 600 N. State (outside store)
Approved unanimously.

Justin said the city crew has been working on the water lines on Quigg. He said they will be moving to work on Cedar Street next.


