## Utility Services

Your Utility bill for water, sewer, and sanitation services will be mailed out on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. Payment will be due by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month. City utilities are billed in advance. Example: Billing date May 1<sup>st</sup> is for services for the month of May. Partial months will be prorated.

Payments not received within 45 days of your billing will become delinquent.

Additional fees may be applied to delinquent accounts. Orange tag notification will result in a \$25 dollar fee and 24 hour notice of shut off.

If your utilities have been shut off due to delinquent payment a \$50 fee will be applied to turn services back on.

You may pay utilities online at [www.cishelley.id.us](http://www.cishelley.id.us). A fee of 3% plus \$1 will apply to all card transaction.

Please contact City Hall if you have any questions concerning your account.

## Garbage pickup

Commercial trash will be picked up Monday and Thursday.

Residential Trash on the East side of the City will be picked up on Tuesday

Residential Trash on the West side of the City will be picked up on Wednesday.

Please have your cans out on the curb by 7am for pickup. Please remove can from the curb by the next morning.

City Spring and Fall clean-up will be generally April and October. During this time you may place your ORGANIC DEBRIS CURBSIDE for pick up. Exact dates for cleanup will be posted on your utility bill for that month, or watch for dates to be posted on marquee.

## **Pet Licenses**

A Pet License is required for all dogs residing in the City limits of Shelley. A pet license is required regardless of whether they are kept indoors or outdoors. Licensing your pet is the best assurance for a safe return of a lost pet.

You may have up to two (2) dogs within the city limits. Dog License can be purchased at City Hall and must be renewed yearly.

Livestock, chickens, farm animals, Bees and Dog Kennels are NOT permitted in the City Limits. In most cases please contact City Hall for more info if you have questions.

**Building Permits:** If you plan to make any structural changes to your property or buildings please contact City building inspector to obtain a permit. Cosmetic upgrades would not require a permit.

If you are not sure if a permit is required you may contact our city building inspector at 208-357-7932 or 208-681-3391

City council meetings are on every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday at 7:30pm every month. Get a better idea of what is going on in town. If you wish to address the mayor and council you must be placed on the agenda no later than 3:00pm on the Friday prior to the meeting you wish to attend.

## **Snow Removal:**

Vehicles must be off the city streets November 15<sup>th</sup> through March 15<sup>th</sup> from 8:00am to 6:00pm when snow is falling or there is a visible amount of snow on the street and the Street has not been plowed since snowfall. Pursuant to City Code 9-9-3.

You may also sign up for text wire to be notified of snow emergencies and other info.
